3. Purpose and legal basis of the processing of personal data

We process your personal data insofar as this is necessary for implementing the Guidelines on the Promotion of Digital Immediate Equipment (Supplementary Agreement to the Administrative Agreement Digital Pact Schools) at schools in regions of North Rhine-Westphalia. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is based on a legal basis pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit. c GDPR.

4. Categories of recipients (internal or external forwarding of personal data)

You have the right to be informed of which data recipients receive your data on an occasion-related or case-related basis, either regularly or following requests. As education authority, we are obliged to maintain the mobile end devices via Mobile Device Management (MDM). Accordingly, your data in connection with the mobile end device are processed via

- AppleSchool Manager
- JAMF MDM.

In addition to the processing of your personal data by the Municipality of Bocholt, your school will receive access to your data. Transfer to third countries will take place; corresponding data-protection-law bases pursuant to Art. 44 ff. GDPR have been established.

5. Duration of the storage

We store your personal data only for as long as necessary for the fulfilment of our statutory duties. As a rule, we keep personal data for one year following return of the mobile end device. Deviating periods can result in particular from terms and conditions of contract.

6. Rights as data subject

All persons who are the subject of data processing have the following rights in particular under the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

- a. Right of access to the data stored on your person and their processing (Article 15 GDPR).
- b. Right of rectification if your data are incorrect or incomplete (Article 16 GDPR).
- c. Right of erasure of the data stored on your person insofar as one of the preconditions of Article 17 GDPR applies and, among other things, no statutory obligations stand in the way of this (Art. 17 (3) GDPR).
- d. Right to restriction of the processing of your personal data insofar as the preconditions pursuant to Article 18 GDPR apply.
- e. Right of data portability for data stored on your person insofar as there is no public interest in the processing (Art. 20 (3) GDPR).
- f. Right to object to specific data processing, insofar as no compelling public interest exists in the processing that overrides the interests of the data subject, and no legal regulation makes processing compulsory (Article 21 GDPR).

7. Right to revoke consent

You have the right to file an objection at any time against the processing of personal data on you, carried out on the basis of your consent, for reasons resulting from your particular situation.

8. Right to complain

All data subjects have the right to complain to the supervisory authority if they are of the opinion that their personal data are being processed unlawfully (Art. 77 GDPR).

9. Obligation to provide

You are legally obliged to provide us with your personal data. This obligation results from the legal basis under Point 3 of this information letter. If you do not provide your data, this can result in us not providing you with a mobile end device.
