– What belongs to the old clothes?

- Wearable, clean clothes
- Bed linen
- Table linen
- Shoes bundled in pairs

– What does not belong to the old clothes?

- Rags
- Fabric scraps
- Stuffed animals, toys
- Torn, dirty, unusable clothes
- Curtains
- Blankets

– What do I have to consider?

Please only put old clothes **in sealed bags** in the containers or at the old clothes collection.

Please make sure to put the bags in **the containers** and not next to them.

Rags, fabric remnants and other unusable items are residual waste and **belong in the residual waste bin**.
