Travel downstream on the "**Bocholter Aa**" in large inflatable boats from Jahnstraße in Rhede to the **LWL Museum Textliwerk Bocholt**. On this leisurely paddle trip you will reach the Bocholter Aasee, take a well-deserved break here at the beach café and marvel at the Chinese pavilion on the Aasee island. After a trip across the Bocholter Aasee, the paddle tour ends at the northern end of the lake on Uhlandstraße.

After a short walk along the Bocholt Aa you will reach the city centre, where you can end the day in a nice restaurant. If you wish, we can book a restaurant for you.

This offer can be booked on individual dates for groups, clubs or company outings of 10 - 100 people.
