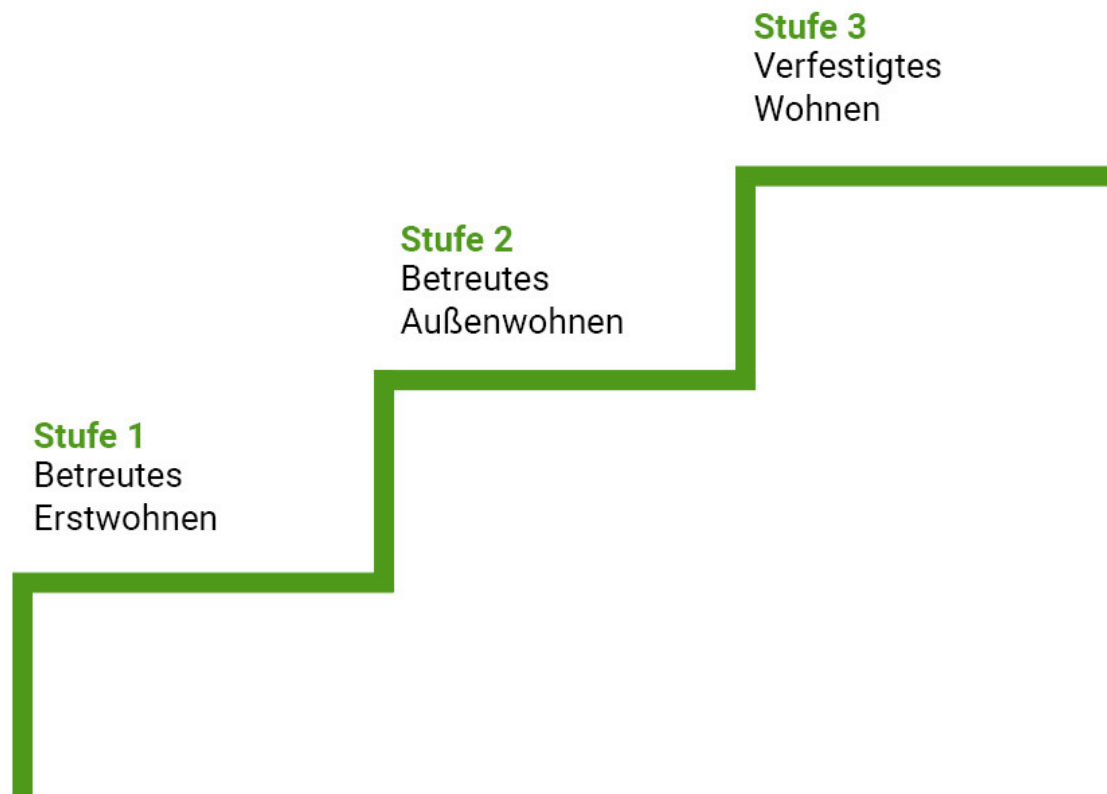


Statistics: Refugees in Bocholt



Level 1

Assisted first-time living

This level of accommodation is used immediately after being assigned to Bocholt. It is used for arrival and initial orientation in Bocholt. Among other things, the refugees are registered.

Level 2

Assisted external living

Assisted external living is characterised by the fact that closed living space is made available. Accommodation is usually decentralised in rented flats.

Level 3

Stabilised living

Before moving into your own living space, a handover meeting is held with the neighbourhood management and the previously responsible social support service.
