## New town centre for Suderwick: town invites to information evening

### Reconstruction of the village square and Sporker Strasse West // Implementation of initial measures

Bocholt's Suderwick district is getting a facelift: the urban planning office WoltersPartner from Coesfeld has already drawn up an initial concept for the redesign of Suderwick in 2023/2024. There will be an information evening for citizens in the coming week.

The village centre development concept (OKEK) includes the redesign of Sporker Straße, the village square, the square of the Protestant church and part of Wiggerstraße. The aim of the OKEK is in particular to increase the quality of stay, strengthen the village square and adapt the village centre to the consequences of climate change. All of this is to be carried out taking into account the *Centrumvisie*, the concept for the remodelling of Dinxperlo.

In March 2025, the town council decided to press ahead with the concept for the design of the village centre. To this end, funding applications are to be submitted to the district government for the village square and for the Sporker Straße section between the border and the village square. The previous design draft, which was created by WoltersPartner, is now being concretised by nts Ingenieursgesellschaft mbH.

We would like to inform you about the current status and the next steps for and in Suderwick.

To this end, a public information event will be held on 10 February 2026 at 7 pm in the parish hall of the Protestant church in Suderwick, Johannes-Meis-Straße 2. Registration is not required.
