## City invites you to the second Energy & Refurbishment IMPULSE

### Continuation of the event series // Focus on living comfort and technology // Free participation after registration

The city of Bocholt is continuing its information series on the heating transition and invites you to the second Energy & Refurbishment IMPULSE on 19 February 2026 at 5 pm at Kaiser-Wilhelm-Straße 52-58. The event offers citizens practical guidance for the energy modernisation of their own homes in a small group. The focus will be on combining technical refurbishment with personal cosiness.

The heating transition is more than just a political goal, it is becoming a reality. The foundation for this lies in people's own homes. Following the successful launch in January, the city of Bocholt is therefore inviting people to the second Energy & Refurbishment IMPULSE, continuing the practical information and dialogue format.

Bocholt has created the strategic framework with the municipal heat planning adopted last year. Now it's all about implementation and the question: What does this mean in concrete terms for my building? This is exactly where the event format comes in. Together with experienced local energy and refurbishment consultants, the city wants to inform citizens, provide guidance and encourage them to take the next steps.

Energy-efficient refurbishment has several advantages: noticeably lower energy costs, greater living comfort, attractive state subsidy programmes and an active contribution to local climate protection. Especially in view of the fact that many older buildings still consume unnecessarily high amounts of energy. The second Energy & Refurbishment IMPULSE shows how these opportunities can be utilised - in an understandable and practical way.

### **Compact thematic impulse**

The event is deliberately limited to a maximum group size of 20 participants to ensure an intensive dialogue. A local expert in energy and refurbishment will first provide a thematic impulse under the title "Technical Comfort: Comfort in Refurbishment". Aspects such as the building envelope, modern building technology and current state funding opportunities will be highlighted. Topics such as the use of renewable energies, the energy performance certificate and measures for climate adaptation and heat protection can also be discussed as part of the open dialogue.

### **Online registration possible**

With this offer, the city administration wants to break down barriers and enable participants to clarify individual questions directly with experts from the region. Participation in the event at the city administration at Kaiser-Wilhelm-Straße 52-58 is free of charge.
