On Thursday, October 27, the theater "Die Komplizen" comes with their puppet show "Urmel hatches from the egg" in the community center Biemenhorst, Willi-Pattberg-Ring 2, 46395 Bocholt. The theater starts at 3 pm. All interested children from the age of 4 are invited to get to know Urmel and his story.
