Although she initially rejects his advances, a friendship eventually develops between the two. When Gary pursues his dream of becoming an actor and goes to an audition, Alana accompanies him as a chaperone. The world slowly changes around them politically and culturally.

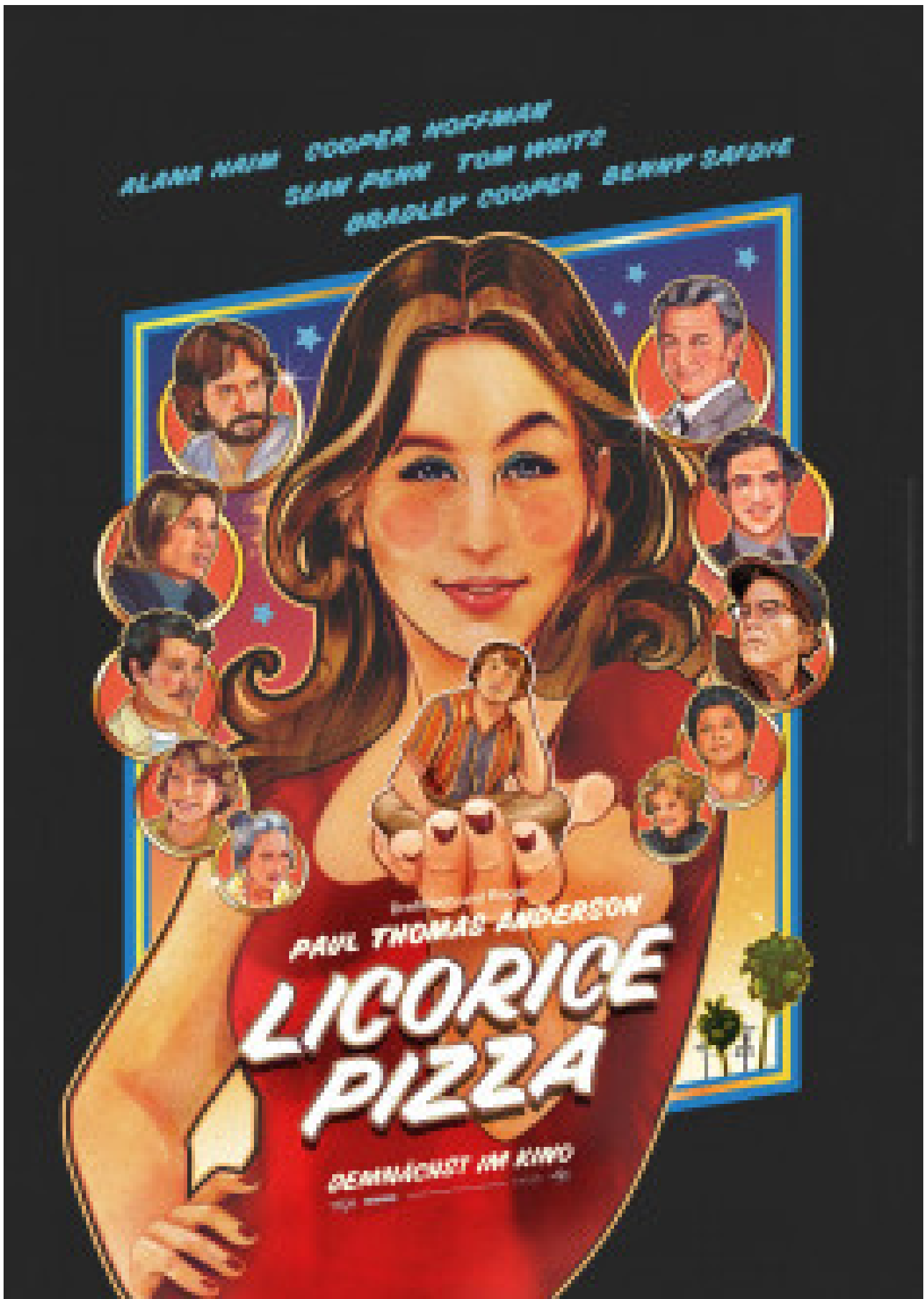
