La Scala in Milan is one of the most renowned and important opera houses in the world. This captivating documentary shows the development of La Scala since its opening in 1931, offering a glimpse behind the scenes and following the artists in their gruelling work - from directing and conducting to dancing and singing. The film shows the spectacular work of the performers at La Scala in Milan, where everyone works with absolute passion towards the premiere.
