Environmental clown action celebrates anniversary

50th performance at Bocholt kindergartens // Collaboration with the old people's theatre "Die Spätzünder"

Whether it's the topic of dog excrement, carelessly throwing away rubbish, avoiding rubbish or sorting rubbish, the different areas are taught with a lot of fun and great commitment from all involved. "In the course of the programme, the children can always get active themselves," says Kalka-Freundt. They quickly catch on and enthusiastically sing "rubbish songs", eagerly sort rubbish into a set-up "sorting station" and discuss the issue of too much rubbish.

The campaign started at the "St. Barbara" kindergarten on Mussumer Kirchweg. According to Kalka-Freundt, this was the 50th event of this kind. Further events will take place at the Wildwiese kindergarten and the St. Josef kindergarten, and finally the Siekids kindergarten will enjoy the educational event.
