Online seminar for women: Digital applications - what to watch out for

An online seminar on Tuesday, May 24, will explain what to look for in a digital application portfolio. It is aimed at young women. The structure and design of contemporary (digital) application documents will be shown, as well as typical mistakes and pitfalls that lurk in e-mail and online applications. Digital options for job searches and self-presentation are also covered.
