The next German-Dutch Stammtisch will take place on Tuesday, 16 May. The meeting place this time is the Grenslan Museum in the Dutch border town of Dinxperlo (Markt 3). The meeting starts at 7:30 pm. The meeting is open to the public.

The German-Dutch Stammtisch meets a few times a year at certain places that symbolise cross-border issues. This time there will be a guided tour of the museum.
