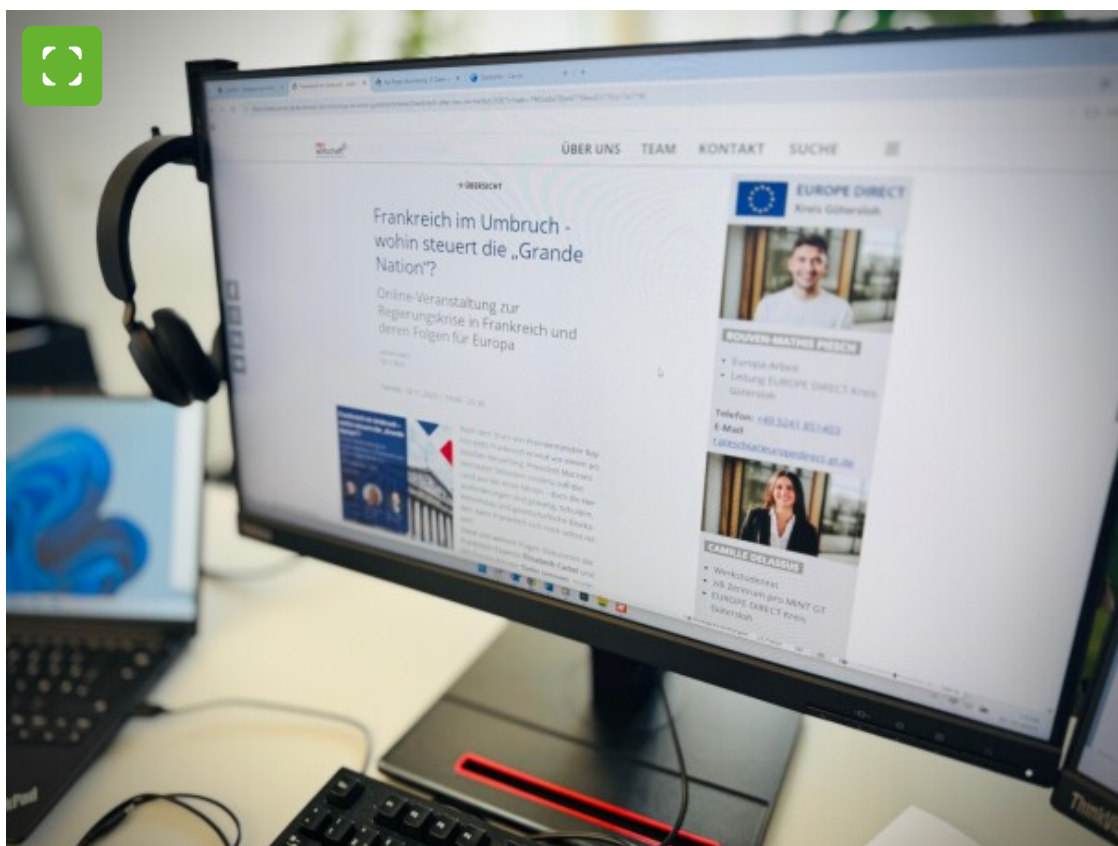
Online event: France in transition - where is the "Grande Nation" heading?
