Associations and organisations that are committed to children and young people can now apply with their own contributions for the design. Mayor Christian Mangen has taken on the patronage of this project.

For the upcoming edition of the Bocholt Family Planner, the Child Protection Association and the city administration are asking for the help of local clubs, organisations and institutions. The aim of the joint project, which is also supported by Stadtparkasse Bocholt and stadtwerker, is to clearly illustrate the wide range of offers for children and young people in the city. The project is aimed in particular at stakeholders from the fields of sport, music, culture and social affairs who would like to present their work and programmes for young citizens to a wide audience.

If more than twelve entries are received by the Kinderschutzbund office, a selection process will decide on the final placement of the entries.
