## **"Future City Bocholt" looks back**

### **Closing event on November 19, 11 a.m. - 1 p.m., at the office at 49 Nor St.**

December marks the end of the third and final project phase for the city of Bocholt in the "City of the Future" competition, which is funded by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research. A reason to look back on what has been achieved. The conclusion of this project, which has been running for a total of seven years, will be celebrated in a relaxed atmosphere. The event will take place on Saturday, November 19, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the office at Nordstraße 49.

Among others, citizens who were initially selected in a random process and have participated in various actions and in working groups over the years are invited, as well as research, cooperation and corporate partners who have become part of the "City of the Future 2030+ - Breathing Bocholt" in various forms.

On Saturday, the various measures and activities of the project and the results will be presented in the Future Office in Nordstraße. The scientific partners of the project will be available for questions and discussions on the individual topics.
