- is a non-partisan and religiously unaffiliated interest group.

- is elected in the form of delegates. All clubs, associations and groups active in local work with senior citizens in Bocholt nominate people for the delegates' assembly. The assembly then elects the members of the seniors' advisory council from among its members.
- is elected for 6 years, the election period is linked to the election period of the city council.
