Demographic change and the associated ageing of society are on everyone's lips. In Bocholt, the proportion of people over 60 is around 22% and the demographic development forecast shows that this proportion will steadily increase. However, the increase in life expectancy and the change in the age structure can also be associated with an increasing need for help.

Older people and their relatives therefore need a contact point to which they can turn with questions arising from the special situation of their stage of life. For this reason, the city of Bocholt has set up a senior citizens' office. Here, senior citizens and their relatives receive help, advice and information on all areas relevant to senior citizens. We help

- in finding support if you want to live in your home and social environment for as long as possible
- when applying for social benefits to finance assistance
- in case of personal difficulties in all questions of daily life

We provide independent **advice**

- on questions of long-term care insurance
- about the offers of outpatient and inpatient help
- about services for caring relatives
- on housing options in old age.

We provide **information**

- about opportunities for voluntary work
- about leisure activities for older people in Bocholt
- about events for senior citizens
- about existing senior citizens' groups in Bocholt.

Another area of responsibility of the senior citizens' office is to meet people's desire for comprehensive and up-to-date information on topics relevant to senior citizens. We therefore regularly offer - sometimes in cooperation with other partners - events, further education, visits to facilities - and much more.
